COMMUNITY SERVICE

Adopt-a-Park Project

Beautify a local park with landscaping and cleanup while inviting conversations.

Bike Repair Workshop

Offer free bike tune-ups, connecting with families as they wait.

Book Drive and Giveaway

Collect and distribute books for all ages, focusing on Christian resources.

Car Wash for Christ

Provide free car washes and offer prayer or a Gospel message to those who come through.

Community Chalk Day

Cover sidewalks with vibrant, faith-filled messages.

Community Cleanup

Tackle neighborhood beautification projects while building meaningful connections with residents.

DIY Gardening Kits

Provide kits with soil, seeds, and instructions tied to Biblical lessons.

Gardening for Good

Plant flowers or vegetables in neglected spaces, inviting conversations about renewal and growth in Christ.

Hydration Stations
